Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy's (FSBPT) Course Work Tool (CWT):

Effective February 1, 2015, the FSBPT guidelines for interpreting the CWT changed regarding general education in North Carolina. (For details, go to www.fspt.org). All course content areas are still required; however, there is no longer a distinction between General Education (Gen Ed) and Professional Education. See the following example:
